

National Martial Arts Masterships Committee (NMC)

Regulations

New Enactment 2018. 09. 07.

Partial Amendment 2021. 03. 04.

Article 1 (Definition) National Martial Arts Masterships Committee (‘NMC’ in abbreviation) is the national committee which host the Masterships as the national level and supply Masterships Movement.

Article 2 (Purposes and Roles) ① National Martial Arts Masterships Committee (referred to as the “NMC” hereafter) promote and protect the Masterships Movement in accordance with WMC Charter.

② NMC shall comply and implement the World Anti-Doping Code.

③ The NMC aims at social values including peace, human rights, and fair competition, and reject antisocial behaviors such as discrimination, violence, and match fixing.

④ The NMC is able to approve martial arts organizations of each country as member organizations under the procedures.

⑤ Once the NMC is established, the NMC has exclusive right to represent the country in the Continental and Regional Competitions which is sponsored by World Martial Arts Mastership Committee (referred to as the “WMC” hereafter), and the NMC shall organize and dispatch the team representing the country.

⑥ The NMC shall ensure that the athletes participating in the competition comply with the rules prescribed by the international federations(IFs) of each martial art.

⑦ Once the NMC is established, the NMC is able to select the host city of the World Martial Arts Masterships in its own country in consultation with the WMC. In addition, if the country host World Martial Arts Masterships, the NMC will actively support the establishment and operation of the organizing committee.

⑧ The NMC shall be able to cooperate with the both governmental and non-governmental organizations of the country, but they must maintain autonomy from any political, legal, religious or economic pressure that may undermine the World Martial Arts Masterships Charter.

Article 3 (Composition) ① The NMC shall be headquartered in its representing country, and the jurisdiction shall be consistent with the territorial scope of the country.

② The NMC may be established as an independent organization from the government, an organization affiliated to the National Olympic Committee, an organization affiliated to the National Sports and Sports Council, or an organization affiliated to the Government's physical education and sports ministry.

③ The NMCs shall be composed as follows.

1. If there are members of the WMC in the country belonging to the NMC, then all members of the WMC shall be appointed as ex-officio members of the Executive Board with voting rights.

2. Representative of all domestic martial arts organizations in the martial arts that are affiliated to the World Martial Arts Masterships.

3. The NMC may include members as follows.

3.1. Athlete representatives who has experience of participating in World Martial Arts Masterships.

3.2. Representatives of national association of International Martial Arts Federation which is approved by WMC even if the Martial Art is not included in the World Martial Arts Masterships.

3.3. Nationality holders who is considered to be able to develop the NMCs through consultation with the WMC or who can contribute to the World Martial Arts Masterships Movement.

④ To maintain the political neutrality, neither the government nor other public authority may appoint a NMC member. However, representative of government or public institution may become a member, and allowed to consult with the WMC to appoint the president and a member when establishing the NMC.

Article 4 (Approval) ① Once the NMC is organized, the NMC shall submit the attached application form to the WMC and WMC shall approve the NMC establishment through the General Meeting after the decision of the Executive Board.

② The NMCs must have its own articles of association, the final approval and amendment of the articles of association shall be reported to the WMC.

③ The NMCs must appoint its president and members according to its articles and hold a general meeting once a year according to its articles.

④ The NMCs are not able to approve more than two martial art organizations as a member in a single martial art.

⑤ The NMCs must include at least three national martial arts organizations in the category of the WMC official martial arts, and the martial arts organizations belonging to the NMC should not have any conflicts between National martial arts organizations and the Internati

onal Federations of WMC official martial arts.

⑥ According to Article 19 of the World Martial Arts Masterships Charter, WMC may grant the status of Member Organizations (Official MO, Associate MO, and Observer) to the NMCs, and the approval process follows the World Martial Arts Masterships Charter.

Article 5 (Rights) ① The designation “National Martial Arts Masterships Committee” may be used, and the name of the country must be included.

② Dispatch the relevant national team to the World Martial Arts Masterships, and consult with the WMC to select the bid city.

③ Under the approval of the WMC, a portion of the assets of World Martial Arts Masterships can be used.

④ Participate in an organization belonging to the WMC or participate in activities sponsored or organized by the WMC.

Article 6 (Obligation) ① In the event of a violation with the World Martial Arts Masterships Charter, the WMC may impose sanctions and other measures against the relevant NMCs. The NMCs shall follow such sanctions and other measures. However, the WMC shall give the NMCs an opportunity for explanation before the decision of the Executive Board.

② The NMCs which were approved by WMC must pay certain amount of membership fee and annual fee to WMC at the time proposed by WMC.

③ The National Martial Arts Masterships Committee must submit a report to the WMC Secretariat every year after its composition.

ADDENDA (2018. 09. 07.)

Article 1 (Enforcement Date) These regulations will be enforced from the date they are voted in the executive board meeting.

Article 2 (Interim Measure) Any issues proceeded before the enforcement of these regulations are considered as followed these regulations.

ADDENDA (2020. 09. 16.)

These regulations will be enforced from the date they are voted in the executive board meeting.
